10. Write a brief message to your friend that you are not attending his birthday party as you have suddenly developed a stomach ache.

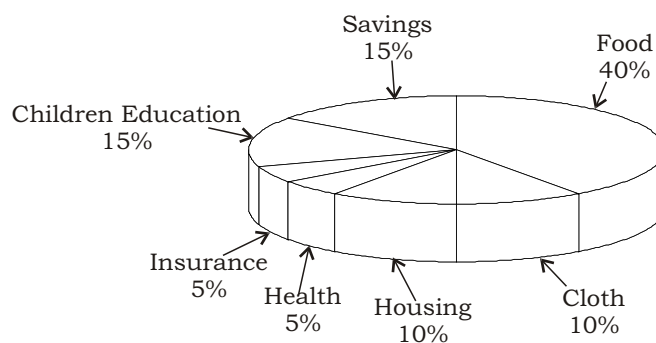
